NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Village Board of the Village of Brocton, New York, at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Village Board held on September 19, 2018, duly adopted the following resolution subject to a permissive referendum pursuant to the General Municipal Law of the State of New York, an abstract of which follows:

IN THE MATTER OF THE DETERMINATION TO DISSOLVE THE VILLAGE JUSTICE COURT

WHEREAS, Village James Craig recently passed away; and

In the matter of the determination to dissolve the Village Justice Court - WHEREAS the Justice James Craig recently passed away; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board investigated the continued economic wisdom of continuing to fund the Village Justice Court; and

WHEREAS, the Board decided that it would be economically beneficial to abolish the Village Justice Court.

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Brocton hereby resolves, pursuant to the Village Law Section 3-301(2)a to abolish the Village Justice Court effective January 1, 2019; and be it further,

RESOLVED, that this Resolution is subject to permissive referendum as required by law.
